

## PROCEDURE for APPLICATION

1. Check the list of requirements at the Registrar's Office or visit [www.lsg.edu.ph/gs](http://www.lsg.edu.ph/gs).
2. Submit the complete requirements.
3. Fill out the application form.
4. Pay the testing fee at the Business Office.
5. Present the receipt of payment at the Registrar's Office.
6. Issuance of test/interview schedule and exam permit.
7. Take the entrance test on the scheduled date of testing.

For Grades 2 to 6 applicants: Interview will be conducted by school administrators after the entrance examination.



## ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

The testing schedule is determined at the time of application.

Applicants are requested to be at the Testing Room at least 30 minutes before the testing schedule. Latecomers will not be allowed to take the test; however, they may be rescheduled for testing.

## RELEASE of ADMISSION RESULTS

The results are released 5 working days from the date of testing.

# LA SALLE GREEN HILLS

Founded in 1959 by the La Salle Brothers, the school has become a landmark in the field of education, an institution known for its high standard of excellence in all areas of endeavor. La Salle Green Hills stands on a 6-hectare piece of prime property along Ortigas Avenue in Mandaluyong City.

## VISION-MISSION

La Salle Green Hills is a Lasallian Catholic educational institution that is internationally recognized, learner-centered, and service-oriented in pursuit of social transformation.

## ACCREDITATION

The Grade School was formally accredited by the Philippine Accrediting Association of Schools, Colleges, and Universities (PAASCU) on March 15, 1974. The school has since undergone several subsequent PAASCU visits. On August 30, 1993, La Salle Green Hills received the rare distinction of being granted a 7-year accreditation by the same association.

On May 31, 2008, the Federation of Accrediting Association of the Philippines (FAAP) granted the department Level III status with flying colors under Memorandum Order No. 32 series of 2006 of DepEd, making it the first elementary school in the Philippines to be accorded such honor.

In November 2009, the Grade School department underwent another PAASCU re-survey wherein the revised evaluation instrument was used. In May 2010, the Grade School earned another mark in history, having been granted another 5-year (full curricular deregulation) Level III status by PAASCU.

The most recent accreditation was conducted last November 13-14, 2014. Once again, the LSGH Grade School was granted a five-year (full curricular deregulation) Level III status by PAASCU last May 2015.

Readiness for Nursery and Kindergarten is determined by a standardized test, the results of which are the objective criteria for determining admission.

## REQUIREMENTS:

1. NSO/PSA Birth Certificate
2. Application form
3. LSGH Recommendation form filled out by any 2 of the following: Principal/Guidance Counselor/ Homeroom Adviser/Subject Teacher (Grades 1 to 6 only)
4. Certificate of enrolment (Kindergarten only)
5. Current school year's report card with the following grade requirements in any grading period (Grades 2 to 6 only)
  - 5.1 Average of at least 80
  - 5.2 No failing grade
  - 5.3 A conduct or deportment grade of at least S or its numerical equivalent
6. Previous school year's report card with the following final grade requirements (Grades 2 to 6)
  - 6.1 No final grade lower than 80
  - 6.2 A final average of at least 85
  - 6.3 No failing grade in any grading period
  - 6.4 A conduct or deportment grade of at least S or is numerical equivalent
7. Two recent ID pictures with white background (2x2)
8. For Foreign applicants:
  - 8.1 Passport
  - 8.2 Alien Certificate of Registration (ACR Card)
9. Entrance examination fee
